

New Grace House Rules

1. Residents must sign in and out of house on all trips.
2. No drinking or drug use. If you suspect someone of using, please notify staff.
3. All residents are subject to random alcohol/drug screens (room inspections included).
4. Violence or threats of any kind will result in immediate eviction.
5. Destruction of Grace House property will result in immediate eviction.
6. No microwaves or refrigerators in personal rooms
7. Gambling and adult movies are prohibited.
8. Everyone not working must be out of bed and properly dressed (room/area cleaned, bed made by 8:00 AM). When working and up for the day (room/area cleaned, bed made properly).
9. If you are unemployed you must be out of the house from 9:00 am to 1:00 pm (except weekends). Must sign in and out daily.
10. All residents that are not employed must be seeking employment.
11. Kitchens, bathrooms, all common areas are to be cleaned after each use.
12. Chores are to be done daily. Non compliance will result in consequences.
13. Radios and TV's turned down low noise level down at 10:00 PM until 8:00 AM.
14. Second shift workers are to respect the other residents when coming in from work.
15. Curfew is 10:00 PM during restrictions and 12:00 AM when restrictions are lifted.
16. Residence will be on restriction for 30 days (see staff).
17. Pass request must be submitted by Wednesday for Friday or Saturday night pass. (one night only unless okayed by Director for more days out).
18. Food allowed in the living area/or private rooms must be cleaned up after use of that food item daily.
19. Visitors are allowed in the first floor common areas only, from 12:00 pm to 7:00pm on weekdays on weekends 12:00pm to 9:00 pm.
20. Everyone must have two forms of identification to enter The Grace House.
21. Rent is due on Friday, must be one pay period in advance, weekly, biweekly, or monthly to be current.
22. All outstanding court issues are to be addressed. Probationary agreements are to be upheld.
23. Probation will be notified of an eviction only if probation asks to be notified.
24. Any resident committing a criminal offense will result in immediate eviction.
25. Any resident that has any type of prescribed medication needs to notify staff immediately.
26. All residents are to lock all doors when entering and leaving the house.
27. There will be a \$5.00 fee for any lost keys.
28. Residents are required to attend three twelve step meetings weekly one of which must be outside of house (AA/NA)
29. Residents "covering" for a violation of rules will result in immediate eviction or house restriction with added chores at the house.
30. Residents have one week to pick up their belongings and to settle their accounts after discharge.
31. Wednesday and Saturday's Hope's Alive meeting is mandatory unless you are working.
32. Attending church of your choice on Sunday is mandatory.
33. Sunday house meeting is mandatory.

Drug/Alcohol Use Offenses

1st offense – 72 hours out of house and reentering upon clean test

2nd offense – 1 week out of house and reentering upon clean test

3rd offense – Immediate eviction

I have read and understand the rules of The Grace House. I agree to follow them to the best of my ability. Violation of any of these rules can be grounds for eviction. I have also received a copy of these rules.
